

# Burgher Association Australia Incorporated (BAA)



## Code of Conduct

Members & Guests shall conduct themselves in an orderly manner at all times whilst on the premises of the BAA.

Any conduct deemed unacceptable may result in suspension or loss of Membership per the Constitution of the BAA and at the discretion of the Committee of Management.

### **UNACCEPTABLE CONDUCT**

- ▶ Foul or abusive language.
- ▶ Menacing behaviour towards Members or Guests.
- ▶ Refusal to leave the premises when legally requested to do so or, having done so, attempts to re-enter the premises.
- ▶ Over indulgence of alcohol.

**It is expected that Members & Guests of the Association will at all times.**

- ▶ Be friendly, courteous and respectful towards other Members and Guests.
- ▶ Refrain from behaviour that would bring the BAA into disrepute.
- ▶ Refrain from behaviour that would offend or embarrass others.
- ▶ Behave in non-violent and non-abusive ways.
- ▶ Respect the positions of Committee Members.
- ▶ Treat the property and facilities of the BAA with respect.
- ▶ Contribute positively to the social activities of the BAA.

### **MEMBER'S RESPONSIBILITIES**

- ▶ A Member is responsible for the behaviour of any Guest s/he may bring onto the premises.
- ▶ A Member will be held responsible for any damage to BAA property caused by themselves, their Guests or their Children.
- ▶ Children's attendance at the BAA must be supervised by a Member or Guest at all times.

### **ACCEPTANCE**

- ▶ Members and Guests will be deemed to have accepted this Code of Conduct by attending the BAA premises and, may obtain a copy of the Constitution for their own reference.
